

Axiak Boxing/Martial Arts Timer

Thank you for purchasing the *Axiak Timer*, the portable boxing/martial arts/judo timer. The *Axiak Timer* is built to the highest quality standards. No more counting rounds and trying to guess round times. The *Axiak Timer* can be used to time training, sparring, bag workouts, rope workouts, and with its pause/continue feature is excellent for refereeing competitions.

Features:

- Compact, rugged and portable.
- Work times selectable from 30 seconds to 5 minutes in 30-second increments.
- Rest times selectable from 15 second to 2-1/2 minutes in 15-second increments.
- Selected work and rest times retained between uses.
- 10-second countdown to first round.
- High visibility display of rounds 1 to 9 then 0 to 9 (10 to 19).
- High visibility display of time remaining in work time or rest time.
- 10 seconds until end of work time 'blip'.
- Flashing round display during rest time.
- Sounds buzzer 2 times at the start of work time, 3 times at the start of rest time.
- Pause/continue switch for judging and refereeing.

Instructions:

To set work time:

Click the left button until you see the start bracket: [in the top display.

Now keep clicking the right button until the bottom display shows the work time you want.

To set rest time:

Click the left button until you see the end bracket:] in the top display.

Now keep clicking the right button until the bottom display shows the rest time you want.

To start timing:

Click the left button until you see a flashing zero in the top display.

The bottom display will start a 10 second countdown to the first round.

During timing:

Press the left button to turn the timer off (the work/rest times are saved).

Press the right button to pause/continue.

Battery Installation:

- Use a small Phillips head screwdriver to remove the 4 screws joining the enclosure together.
- Open enclosure and insert 2 AA batteries in the battery holder. **Be sure to install the batteries in the directions indicated in the bottom of the battery holder. Installing batteries in the wrong direction could damage the timer.**
- Close the enclosure by holding the two halves firmly together with one hand and tightening the screws with the other hand. **Do not over tighten.**
